Student Acceptable Network Use Agreement

- Students **must** use approved USER ID. Students will be responsible for any activity that occurs through the use of that ID.
- Students **must not** share their passwords or accounts with others and must make every effort to safeguard this information from unauthorized users.
- If you forget your password, you may get your new password in the library if you pay **\$1.00 fee**.
- You may use our computer network for school work only!
- Network drive H: storage is to be used for school assignments only. Each user is limited to maximum of <u>10 Mb</u> of storage space. Accounts exceeding this limit will be suspended for two weeks and cleared without warning!
- Do NOT bring/use floppy disks at school. Use e-mail attachments to send your work to school or home.
- Playing games on the school computers is strictly prohibited.
- □ Internet use must be limited to research related to class assignments.
- \blacksquare Food or drinks are not allowed in the computer labs.
- Do NOT cause damage to hardware and software or any other equipment in the computer labs.
- □ Do NOT plug or unplug anything from any computers.
- Do NOT browse any network and local hard drives; you can browse only your own files on H: drive.
- □ Do NOT save anything on the local C: drive.
- □ The use of unauthorized software is NOT permitted.

- □ Users will NOT send or receive offensive messages or pictures from any source.

- Be POLITE and WELL MANNERED when using e-mail.
- □ Do NOT break copyright laws.
- LOGOFF as soon as you have completed your task.
