The Specialist High Skills Major (SHSM) is a ministry-approved specialized diploma designation. The SHSM allows students to focus their learning on a specific economic sector while meeting the requirements of the Ontario Secondary School Diploma. This career-focused program is designed to bundle courses, cooperative education experience, and sector specific certifications. The SHSM is designed to help students transition from high school into an apprenticeship, college, university, or work place.

Students enrolled in the SHSM will enjoy enhanced reach-ahead opportunities as well as receive certification in First Aid and C.P.R. As part of their training they will also acquire six sector-specific certifications.
