## Guide to Researching Universities

SEEK ANSWERS TO QUESTIONS LIKE THESE WHEN DOING YOUR RESEARCH:

### PROGRAMS & ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

1. What undergraduate **programs** are offered by the university?
2. What **prerequisite** courses are required for the program you are interested in?
3. What is the **anticipated** admission average for the program? Are there any **minimum course marks** required to qualify for admission to this program?
4. What is the admissions policy for **repeated courses** (if you have any repeats/upgrades)?
5. Is there a **minimum number of 4U** courses that this university requires for admission? (Queen's has some limits for 4M courses in some programs).
6. What **other criteria** may be used in determining who is accepted into the program (i.e. Supplementary Application, Essay, Portfolio, Audition, Testing)? What are the dates for these?
7. Is there a paid **Co-op** option in this program?
8. If you are interested in a **professional or second degree** program, what undergraduate courses must you take?
9. Are there opportunities to add or change programs on the application? What are the dates?

### OFFERS OF ADMISSION

10. When will the university be sending out conditional offers of admission? What percentage of applicants are given conditional **"EARLY" offers of admission** (when do these go out)? What are these offers based on (grade 11/12 marks)?
11. What percentage of applicants are given conditional offers in the **"final round"**, after semester 2 mid-term marks are available in May?
12. What conditions must be met in July for these "Conditional Offers" to be **confirmed**?
13. If you are not accepted into your program choice, will the university automatically consider you for an **alternate program**, or must you apply for alternate programs you want to be considered for?
14. If you **apply to more than one program at the university**, will you be considered for ALL your choices?

### APPLICATION PROCESS for September 2019

University applications will be completed on-line. Students may apply at home or on a school computer (payments must be made from a home computer). Tutorials for on-line applications will be offered in November at the school for all students who may be applying to university for September 2019. Students wishing to apply to both College and University must attend both of these tutorials as there are separate applications for college (Ontariocolleges.ca) and university (ouac.ca). In addition, some degree programs are offered by colleges and may require an application through Ontariocolleges.ca.

  - **OUF Passport** – By registering for an OUF Passport at [www.ouf.ca/passport](http://www.ouf.ca/passport), students receive a barcode that they take to the OUF and get scanned at university booths and presentation rooms of their choice. Its the easiest way for them to share their contact information to receive more info about the universities they are interested in. Without an OUF Passport, students must manually enter their contact details at each individual university booth where they request further information. 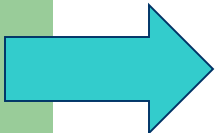

# Key Dates

- **December 14, 2018**

- Deadline for Ancaster High students
- All students should have their application completed, submitted and paid for by this date
- You can still amend your application after you apply

- **January 16, 2019**

- Deadline for Ontario University Application Centre
- Students who have not applied by this date may not be considered for their university choices



# Key Dates...continued

- **February 2019**

- Semester 1 final marks are submitted to OUAC:  
**students must check the accuracy of these marks**

- **March 2019**

- Early offers of admission begin (some exceptions)
- Students not eligible will be reconsidered in May



# Key Dates continued

- **April 2019**
  - Semester two, mid-semester grades are submitted to OUAC
- **May 2019**
  - Final Offers of Admission are given
  - The latest date by which all applicants shall expect:
    - 1) an offer of admission
    - 2) a refusal, or
    - 3) a deferral pending the receipt of more information



# After May ...?

- Students who do not receive an offer here must consider other options
- Some universities will post available programs in early JUNE – through ***Admission Information Services***
- Students can amend their application at this time and be considered for programs with available space





### 3) ACCEPT



- Deadline by which you must reply to a university offer is:

**JUNE 1, 2019**



# Offers of Admission

- ALL offers of admission are **conditional** until you meet ALL requirements of admission
- Each conditional offer of admission will state the **requirements** of the offer
  - *Ex. Must maintain a 78% average*
- ALL conditional offers of admission will be **confirmed OR rescinded** in JULY after final grades are submitted to OUAC



# What is an EARLY offer of admission?

- ALL senior course (3U and 3M) marks are submitted to OUAC
  - This is considered *FULL DISCLOSURE*
- Universities can consider students for admission once their applications have been submitted
- Competitive programs will usually give offers of admission in MAY after semester 2 midterm grades are sent
