<u>Vice principal's report Mr. Currie and Ms. Ferney</u>

- PA Sept 21st, Positive school climate and achievement, and equity and inclusion will be topics for discussion
- We are above board provincial rates for EQAO
- Math and numeracy initiatives for parents and teachers for Grade 1-8
- There has been a review of electronics policy and try to have a standardized policy. Try to use technology in a productive way.
- Open issues:
 - Asbestos concern with leaks, over summer did full asbestos abatement and removed all in East wing, ceiling and floor tiles replaced, upgraded electrical and put LED lights. East wing roof is being replaced, working evening and weekends to cause least disruption to students and for safety reasons.
 - Cameras board will be installing them.
 - New doors, will replace all hallway doors and locks.
- Field upgrade looking at getting a new natural turf field and track beginning of June-November 2019.
- We are scheduled for window replacement of whole school but don't know the date
- Other business: Global news article Waterloo Engineering ranking high schools. Average drop is about 16% for all students. Where it was more than that they published it. The sample size was small but we don't know for sure. Without a context it is just data. Only looked at 2018. We don't know all the information yet. Will report more once we learn more. Mr. Gallant is happy that student's are thinking about it and thinking critically.
