- •5 Grade 10 Compulsory Courses
 - -English ENG2D1(academic or enriched) or ENG2P1(applied)
 - -Math MPM2D1(academic or enriched) or MFM2P1(applied)
 - -History CHC2D1(academic) or CHC2P1(applied)
 -Science SNC2D1 (academic) or SNC2P1 (applied)

 - -Civics & Careers CHVGLC (this is a combined course code)
- Plus 3 electives to total 8 Credits in Grade 10



What are my elective course choices?

- Go to your Option Sheet long white sheet
- Courses are listed by grade level and subject area
- You will get 3 choices
- •You will need a grade 9 or 10 course in your electives in order to take the grade 11 course for ARTS
- You will need the grade 10 Computer Studies to take the Grade 11 Computer Science course (recommended)
- •You will need the grade 10 "language" course to move forward with the grade 11 "language" course



Elective courses

- Make sure you select courses to complete your group 1, 2, and 3 compulsories
- Make sure you have your ARTS credit completed by the end of grade
 10
- You can select grade 10 or 11 courses as electives

- Check the course descriptions and flowcharts in the School Course Calendar
- Talk to your subject teachers about what courses are offered in their departments at the next level
- Talk to your Guidance Counsellor
- Read through the list of courses offered

- Make sure you have the prerequisite course you need and are on the right pathway to support your future goals




Math Pathways Chart

 - If you are going into a math dependent trade, then the higher the level of math the better for your Apprenticeships
- Workplace
 - You can take any level of math

- Each student has an instruction sheet on putting courses into Career Cruising
- Students will log in to Career Cruising through "The Hub"
- If this is the first time logging in through "The Hub" then you will need to use your Career Cruising USERNAME and PASSWORD



Career Cruising — log in

- USERNAME HW- "student number" (on your status sheet)
- PASSWORD- If this is your first time logging in it is your birthday mmddyyyy

If you have logged in before, it is your own password you created

We can access your password and username in guidance

Online Courses

- This year, students have the option of taking some courses online.
- On the options sheets these will have "@" or "#"

Online courses are NOT self paced!



Summer School Courses

- International Baccalaureate
 - Students interested in this should see their Guidance Counsellor or Mr. Taylor



I.B. — International Baccalaureate Diploma

- Ancaster High offers the two year I.B. Diploma Programme, starting in Grade 11
- Students will be granted BOTH an O.S.S.D. and an I.B. Diploma when they graduate



Planning for IB

- Students who may be interested in taking the I.B. Diploma in Grade 11 and 12 should speak with their Guidance Counsellor when planning courses for grade 10
- In grade 10, students must take:
 - ENG2D1E and MPM2D1E Enriched
 - MCR3U1B functions (special class for IB bound students)
 - FSF2D1 if French is the desired second language for IB
- Parents/students should contact Mr. Sheeler our I.B. Co-ordinator for more information about the IB Diploma Programme



SHSM – Aviation and Aerospace

- Students can begin this program in grade 11
- There are no pre-requisites to take this program, but we recommend you take at least one "Technology" courses in Grade 10
- The Aviation and Aerospace S.H.S.M. helps students prepare for a number of careers in the aviation industry
- Students can plan for an apprenticeship, degree program, diploma program, or head directly to the workplace from this program



SHSM — Information & Communication Technology

- Students can begin this program in grade 11
- There are no pre-requisites to take this program, but we recommend you take courses in: communication technology, technological design or computer studies in Grade 10
- ICT S.H.S.M helps students prepare for a number of careers in the media, arts and computer world.
- Students can plan for an apprenticeship, degree program, diploma program, or head directly to the workplace from this program



Taking grade 11 courses in grade 10

- Students can select a grade 11 course to take in grade 10
- Make sure this works for you What is your plan?



Strategies for your future

- Grade 10 is a good year to continue investigating areas of study
