Selecting Grade 12 Courses for 2016-2017

**GENERAL**

1. Students will circle choices on the Ancaster High Option Sheet. Use your Student Status Sheet to make sure you have all graduation requirements completed by June 2017!
2. Option Sheets must be signed by a parent/guardian, then returned to Student Services by Monday, March 7, 2016.
3. FEES: ALL school fees will be paid by "School Cash Online". Please follow the steps below to process the payment of your child's school fees:
  - a. Point your web browser to <https://hwdsb.schoolcashonline.com> and create an account
  - b. Use the Parent Support Helpdesk or contact our Ancaster High Main Office for PIN info.
  - c. Pay appropriate fees (\$20 Student Activity Fee is compulsory).
  - d. Repeat for each child you have attending Ancaster High (each child will be given a unique P.I.N.)
  - e. Any questions? Many details can be found by clicking the "SUPPORT" link on the homepage of <https://hwdsb.schoolcashonline.com>. The Parent Help Desk is available to help anytime at 1-866-961-1803.
4. Option Input: Due Date - Monday, March 7, 2016
  - a. NEW THIS YEAR - Students will input their option choices AT HOME through Career Cruising.
  - b. Find Career Cruising on "The Hub" and follow the instructions on the "Course Input Instruction Sheet": <http://home.hwdsb.on.ca/?user=student>
5. After March Break students will receive an OPTION VERIFICATION SHEET to be signed by a parent/guardian. This will confirm the option choices for the 2016 - 2017 school year.
6. Review the [Secondary Course Calendar](#) carefully before choosing your options. It is available on the Board Website at [www.hwdsb.on.ca/students/coursecalendar/](http://www.hwdsb.on.ca/students/coursecalendar/). Not all of the courses in this calendar are offered at Ancaster High School - only the ones on the option sheet are offered at Ancaster High.

**HOW TO MAKE THE CORRECT CHOICES**

1. Students who have earned a minimum of 24 credits by the end of June 2017 must select between 6 and 8 courses. Make sure you select enough courses to earn the 30 credits required for graduation in June 2017.
2. eLearning: Courses on the Course Selection Sheet marked with # or @ will be available as "eLearning or Online" courses. eLearning courses are delivered similarly to regular courses, there is a teacher directing the pace of the course, there are set due dates and deadlines for course work (these are NOT self-paced courses). Students must have the self-discipline to log-in each day as attendance will be taken in these courses. Please see your Guidance Counsellor for more information on eLearning courses.
3. Specialist High Skills Major Program (Aviation & Aerospace): You will have choice in Major credits to be eligible for this designation: TTL4C1-aviation, TTJ4C1-transportation, TMJ4E1-Manufacturing, TDJ4M1-Design. You must have the proper prerequisite in grade 11 to take the grade 12 course. Use the SHSM Course Chart to make sure you have ALL the required courses for your SHSM designation. See your Guidance Counsellor for more information.



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# What Options **MUST** I Choose?

- Any remaining compulsory courses for graduation
  - Double check your group 1, 2, or 3 credits
- 1 Grade 12 Compulsory Course
  - English **ENG4U1**(university) or **ENG4C1**(college)
- Plus enough electives to graduate
- You **MUST** take a minimum of 3 courses **EACH** semester

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## **What are my elective course choices?**

- Go to your Option Sheet – long white sheet
- Courses are listed by grade level and subject area
- Make sure you have the prerequisite for any grade 12 courses you select
- Remember that co-op counts for 2 credits



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## Elective course prerequisites

- You **MUST** have the grade 11 Tech course to take the grade 12 Tech course
  - (ex. TGJ3M1 for TGJ4M1)
- You **MUST** have the grade 11 ARTS course from the same area to take that course in grade 12
  - (ex. AVI3M1 for AVI4M1 or ADA3M1 for ADA4M1)
- For **MOST** Social Science and Humanities courses – the prerequisite can simply be ENG3U1 , or a grade 11 U or M social science course



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# Information for Grade 12 Courses

- Check the course descriptions and flowcharts in the School Course Calendar
- Talk to your subject teachers about what courses are offered in their departments at the next level
- Talk to your Guidance Counsellor
- Read through the list of courses offered

- Make sure you have the prerequisite course you need and are on the right pathway to support your future goals

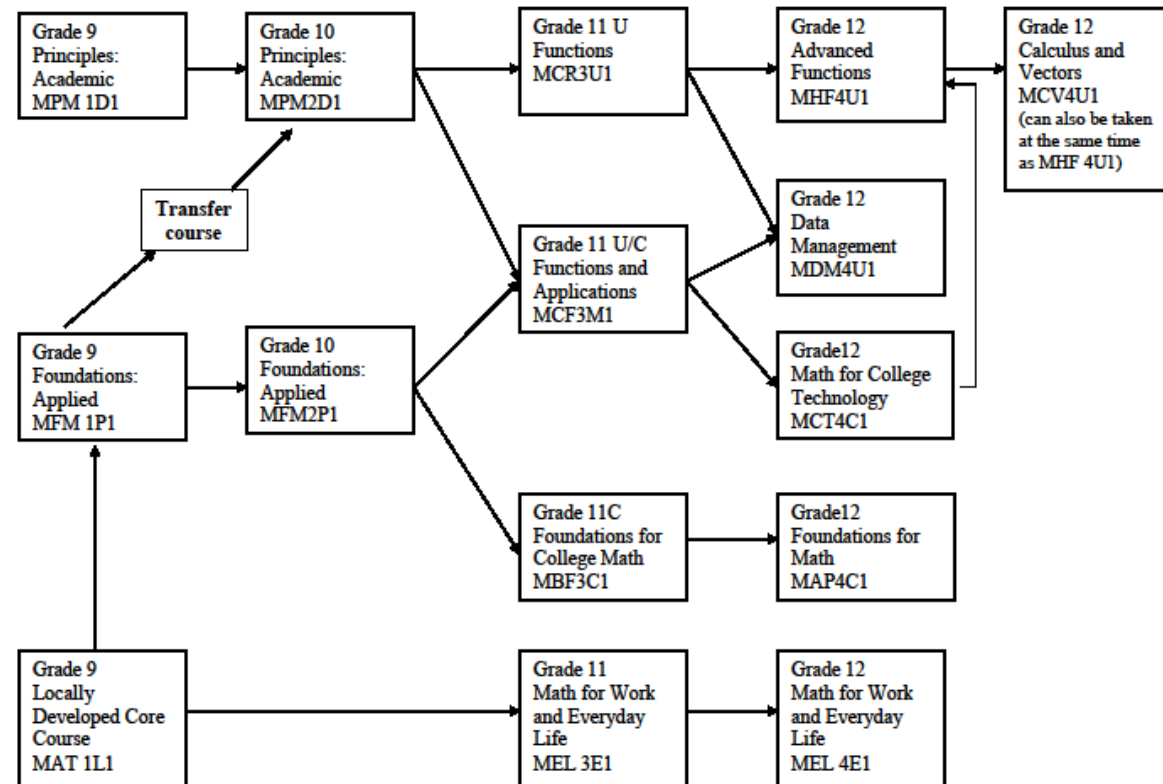

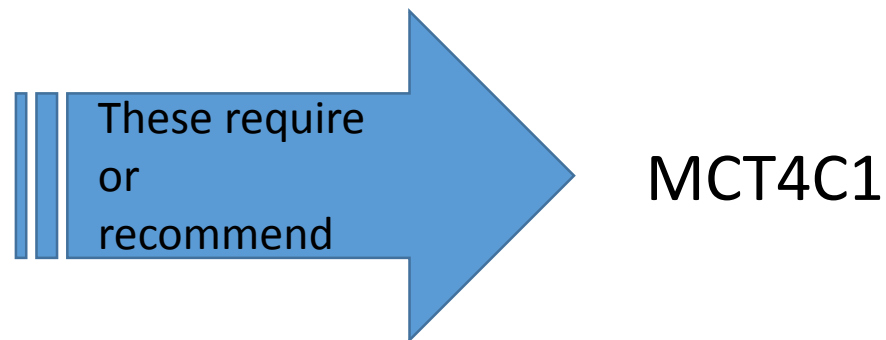

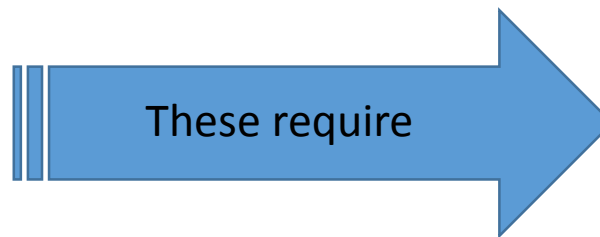

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# Getting Courses Into Career Cruising

- Each student has an instruction sheet on putting courses into Career Cruising
- Students will log in to Career Cruising through “The Hub”
- If this is the first time logging in through “The Hub” then you will need to use your Career Cruising USERNAME and PASSWORD from your instruction sheet



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## Career Cruising – log in

- **USERNAME** - HW- “student number” (on your status sheet)

- If you are registered in SHSM, make sure you complete your requirements
- Students must meet the following criteria by the time they graduate to achieve this designation:
  - 4 major credits
  - 1 math
  - 1 English
  - 1 other
  - 2 co-op credits
  - First Aid/CPR
  - WHMIS
  - 3 certifications





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# SHSM – Information & Communication Technology

- If you are registered in SHSM, make sure you complete your requirements
- Students must meet the following criteria by the time they graduate to achieve this designation:
  - 4 major credits
    - 1 math
    - 1 English
    - 1 other
    - 2 co-op credits
  - First Aid/CPR
  - WHMIS
  - 3 certifications



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# Thinking of Returning? - Post-grad

- Students may return for 1 semester
- Students **MUST** select 3 courses and can apply to go part time if they are a graduate
- Any student wishing to return for the second semester will apply in January
- If you are thinking of a post-grad semester – have a plan
