From the Principal's Desk

As we enter into June, there are many year ending activities being planned and preparations are being made for September 2017-18. Please refer to the calendar in the newsletter for specific dates of various activities. There will be a number of forms coming home for various school trips. In order for students to participate in these activities Trip Forms must be completed and returned to allow them to go on the trip.

Parents should also be aware that in order to **accompany your child on a school trip a police check is required.** These also need to be registered in the office.

Kindergarten Registration

We have already begun taking registrations for all new kindergarten age children (Born in 2013 or before)

To complete official registration we will need the following documentation, **proof of age (either passport, birth certificate or baptismal certificate) and proof of address (parents drivers license or utility bill).**

Safe Arrival

We will not call them down until you arrive.

Safe Schools

Please remember that all adults need to sign in at the office and receive a Visitor Sticker, before they enter the school. As you can appreciate with close to 1000 students and growing, for student safety, we need to account for all adults in the building. We recognize it is nice to wait for your children in the school as they are being dismissed but we ask that you wait outside so we can move the students quickly to their dismissal locations. We have noticed a number of parents inside the connection between the school and portapack, it is a narrow area and we are dismissing 6 classes through the school, please wait outside until your child is dismissed.
