Volunteering at Billy Green

Billy Green School has several opportunities throughout the school year for parents interested in volunteering. Volunteer opportunities include supervising school trips, driving students to and from athletic events, fundraising, school lunch programs, classroom help and more. We are required to follow the HWDSB Volunteer Screening Policy that requires each volunteer to:

- 1. Complete mandatory Vulnerable Sector Screening with Hamilton Police Services every 3 years
- 2. Complete a yearly Offence Declaration form at the school.
- 3. Provide 2 references that you permit the school to contact.
- 4. Complete a mandatory orientation meeting with the Principal or Vice Principal at the school.

This process must be completed in advance of participating in any volunteer opportunities so it is best to complete the process early in the school year so that you are ready for opportunities arise throughout the year. We are especially in need of volunteer drivers for our athletic teams. Please contact the school office to apply to be a volunteer.

School Cash Online

School Cash Online is our preferred method of payment for school events, items and lunches. It is an easy to use and safe way to pay for your children's school fees. Now, with a few clicks, you can pay for your child's yearbook, class trips and so much more from your own home. All you have to do is register an account, attach your children and in no time you will be able to make payments online. School Cash Online is available at all HWDSB schools.

School Cash Online is an on-line payment service offered through the KEV Group. The KEV Group is Canadian owned and operates its head offices in the Province of Ontario. There are over 9,000 schools using KEV's solutions for managing school bookkeeping across North America.

The School Cash Online website is certified compliant with Payment Card Industry (PCI) Data Security Standards. School Cash Online does not share personal information with any third party. They do not store credit card information on their own web servers, computers or other devices. With the exception of funds loaded into MyWallet, your payment information must be entered every time you checkout.

The KEV Group uses Moneris as the payment processor. Moneris is Canada's largest payment processor, processing over 3 billion credit and debit transactions every year.

Billy Green School does not accept personal cheques.

We have **8 buses** of various sizes coming in at the beginning and end of our school day. Please do not use or block the parking lot as it makes it difficult for the buses to maneuver and they are working under timelines.

access transportation details for their student(s). They have further enhanced the portal to allow account holders to choose to receive email notification when their bus is delayed more than 10 minutes.

We do however respect that you may choose to withdraw your child from Billy Green School for the purposes of a family vacation. Please note that a program of study will not be provided by the school and not all areas of the curriculum will be assessed and reflected on the provincial report card. Your child will be removed from the school register after 15 consecutive days of absence. You will be required to re-register your child at the school office upon your return if they are absent for 15 or more days.
