Math, Reading and Writing are components on both the Primary and Junior Assessments.

Here are some suggestions that you might find helpful in supporting your child's learning in Reading at home.

#### PRIMARY

Talk with your child daily about what he or she is reading.

Ask your child to compare people he or she reads about with people he or she knows.

Listen to your child read aloud or read aloud to him or her.

Ask your child for his or her opinion about people or situations.

Talk about the details in the text that can be used to support his or her opinions.

#### **JUNIOR**

Ask your child to explain and tell the meaning of what he or she reads.

Have your child provide reasons for a person's thoughts, feelings or actions.

Listen to your child read aloud.

Have your child summarize the main idea and supporting details after reading.

### \*SCRIBES NEEDED\*

Many of our students need a bit of help getting their thoughts down on paper during the EQAO test. EQAO does allow students to have this accommodation.
