# Fall 2017/Spring 2018

The *Work for Credit* program allows adult students, currently employed fulltime, the opportunity to earn secondary school Cooperative Education credits.

**Cooperative education** is a structured method of combining secondary education with practical work experience. A cooperative education experience, commonly known as a "co-op", provides elective or compulsory group 1-3 credits for structured job experience.

## **Student Eligibility:**

- o student must be over 21 years of age
- o need 4 credits or less (must have earned or currently be earning grade 11 or 12 English)
- o employed fulltime for more than one year

### **Entry Requirements and Registration Information:**

- If you have <u>less than 26 credits</u> you will need to have a credit assessment to qualify for the program, call (905) 521-2554 to book appointment, HWDSB Assessment Centre location: 110 King Street West, Plaza Suite 606
- o If you have <u>26 credits or more</u> (or 23 or more if you started secondary school before 1984) you need to call for an intake meeting at 289-308-6005 or email <u>icharbon@hwdsb.on.ca</u> or <u>ekovacev@hwdsb.on.ca</u>

#### **Course Work:**

The Paid Co-op sessions are 6 weeks long (approx. 240 work hours = 2 course credits). The course is comprised of 2 components:

<u>"In Class" course work:</u> All course material is offered through e-learning, which means all assignments are done online in a virtual classroom. The focus of the course work is on employment and functioning effectively in the workplace. The paid co-op student is responsible for submitting, through the e-learning site, weekly assignments and communications.

<u>"At Work" expectations:</u> The supervisor at the workplace monitors the student's performance and progress, as well as verifies hours worked. The paid co-op student is responsible for their own performance, recording hours and detailing tasks performed.
