### **Registration Instructions**

### **HWDSB HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS:**

With help from your Guidance Counselor determine your eligibility and complete the "Independent Study Registration Form".

Your HWDSB Guidance Counselor will complete an On-Line form to register you for your course with Community and Continuing Education.

Bring your complete form and \$40 (CASH OR DEBIT ONLY) to the Hill Park Learning Centre at 465 East 16<sup>th</sup> Street. **DEBIT payments are NOT accepted during EVENING hours.** 

### **NON-HWDSB HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS:**

With help from your Guidance Counselor determine your eligibility and complete the "Independent Study Registration Form". Make sure that your Guidance Counselor signs and stamps your form and they keep a copy for their records.

Bring your complete form and \$40 (CASH OR DEBIT ONLY) to the Hill Park Learning Centre at 465 East 16<sup>th</sup> Street. **DEBIT payments are NOT accepted during EVENING hours.** 

#### ADULT LEARNERS (over 18 years of age and withdrawn from High School):

\*If you are not yet a High School Graduate, call the Assessment Centre to book a Credit Assessment, 905-521-2554.

If you are a graduate or have already been assessed, come to Hill Park Learning Centre at 465 East 16<sup>th</sup> Street with \$40 (CASH OR DEBIT ONLY) for each course you would like to take. **DEBIT payments are NOT accepted during EVENING hours.** 

\*Adults have one (1) calendar year to complete a course or be automatically withdrawn.
