About the Program

- The Hamilton Wentworth District School Board Strings Instruction Program is offered through Community and Continuing Education. The Strings Program provides an opportunity for children enrolled in grades 4 to 8, attending HWDSB schools, to learn to play the violin or cello. Strings is a fee-for-service program.
- Lessons are taught in the students' home school once a week during the instructional day which means lessons are scheduled during regular class time, nutrition breaks or lunch break. Lessons are also offered at Nora Frances Henderson Secondary School* on Wednesday evenings.
- An Orchestra program is also available as additional opportunity to enhance your child's skills beyond
 the regular lessons and is held on Wednesday evenings at Nora Frances Henderson Secondary School*.
- Weekly lessons are 1/2 hour each in length and Orchestra lessons are one hour in length.
 PLEASE NOTE: Orchestra is only available to students who register for weekly lessons.
- INSTRUMENTS ARE PROVIDED AT NO COST!
- MUSIC BOOK INCLUDED! All students will receive an instructional music book at their own level to use and keep!
- Winter and Spring concerts—All students are invited to showcase their musical accomplishments during each of these performance opportunities.

Registration Information

- Please complete the on-line application and send your payment (with payment form) to the CCE,
 Strings Program by September 14, 2018, so scheduling can be completed. The address information is as shown below.
- A confirmation of lesson dates and times will be emailed by the beginning of October.
- Classes begin in early October 2018 and end in May/June 2019.
- All Cello lessons will be on Wednesday evenings at Nora Frances Henderson Secondary School*.
- We will endeavour to accommodate all registration requests and structure group lessons according to students' skills and abilities.

Musical Instruments

- Families will be asked to sign an "Instrument Use Agreement".
- Students/Parents will be responsible for the care and maintenance of the instrument while in their possession.
- Families may be required to compensate HWDSB for lost or damaged instruments that exceeds normal
 wear and tear. Should the instrument require repair during the period of use, a replacement
 instrument will be provided if available.
- Students who are not returning to the Strings Program in the next school year will be required to return
 their instrument either the evening of the Spring concert or to the Hill Park Learning Centre during
 office hours of 8:30-4:00, between Monday, June 10 and Friday, June 21, 2019.
- Students who are returning, may keep their instrument for use over the summer months. For inventory purposes, parents are requested to email lbarbers@hwdsb.on.ca with the instrument size and ID number. PLEASE NOTE: If a student is not returning and the instrument is not returned by June 21, 2019, there will be a \$20/month late fee assessed.

Withdrawals and Refunds

- Families that wish to withdraw a child from lessons should inform Lorraine Barberstock, Strings Administrator via email lbarbers@hwdsb.on.ca or call (905) 561-2190, ext 4770 for assistance.
- All instruments and accessories are to be returned immediately to the Hill Park Learning Centre.
- Withdrawals from the program prior to October 31st, 2018 the registration fees will be refunded
 minus fees for lessons received and a \$25 administration fee. No refunds will be processed after
 October 31st, 2018.
- Refunds will be returned by cheque. Please allow 4-6 weeks for processing.
- If HWDSB is unable to accommodate your child for lessons, a full refund will be processed.
