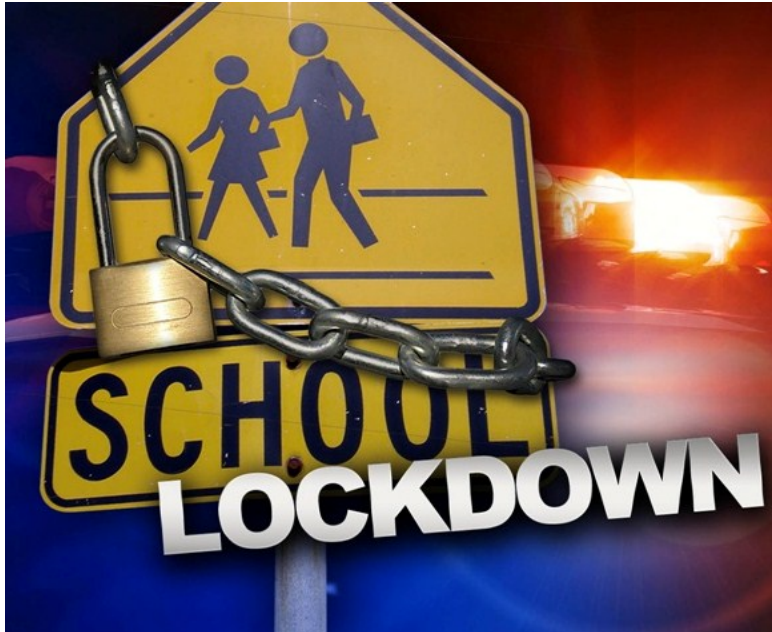

Dear Parents and members of our community;

We are in need of EQAO Scribes

A scribe is an individual who supports the accommodations the student receives on a regular basis for all forms of assessment. Scribes must not be relatives of the students they are assessing.

A scribe must/may

- print by hand or type exactly what the student dictates;
- fill in the circles on the Student Answer Sheet as directed by the student;
- read the dictation back to the student if requested;
- assume each sentence begins with a capital and ends with a period (*for reading and math only*);
- print by hand or type exactly what the student dictates as one long statement with no punctuation or capitalization. The scribe is permitted to spell words correctly (*for writing only*);
- show the student the transcription, after the student has finished dictating his or her work, and ask the student to indicate where capital letters and punctuation should be placed (*for writing only*);
