The Fine Print

1. The contest is open to HWDSB students and staff only. Contest runs from June 29 to August 31, 2018.
2. Each participant must login with their 9 digit OEN number or 7 digit employee ID to check out eBooks and / or eAudio books from eMAX. (OENs are on report cards or available from your school's teacher librarian.)
3. Find eMAX via TheHUB, using the OverDrive app or go to hwdsb.lib.overdrive.com.
4. Parents/legal guardians of participating students are responsible for ensuring the reading / listening material selected by your student for the contest is appropriate.
5. Names of the students and staff who borrow eBooks / e audio books during the contest will be entered into a random draw.
6. One winner from each of the four categories (Primary, Junior/Intermediate, Senior and HWDSB Staff) will be randomly drawn and will receive a \$25 Chapters/Indigo gift card. Winners will be notified at their school or work location by September 30, 2018.

eMAX Digital Library e-Books and e-Audio Books

On a computer, go to HWDSB Student Login Page.



Go to The Hub and sign in with your student username.



Choose Your Library Course



then click My Learning Commons.



Search eBooks in your school library catalogue (search physical, eBooks and eAudio).

Click Here

OR, click eMAX from the Quick Links to search only eBooks and eAudio.



OR, on an iPad, download the Overdrive app to search only eBooks and eAudio.



Log in to eMAX (OverDrive) using your OEN, which has 9 digits. You can get your OEN from your teacher. (Staff log in using your Staff ID #.) You may be asked to choose your school or school board when logging in.

You can borrow eBooks (some are READ-ALONG!) or Audio Books that read to you.

Grade 8 place finished second overall.

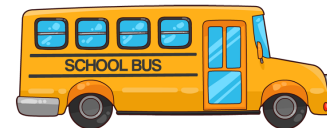

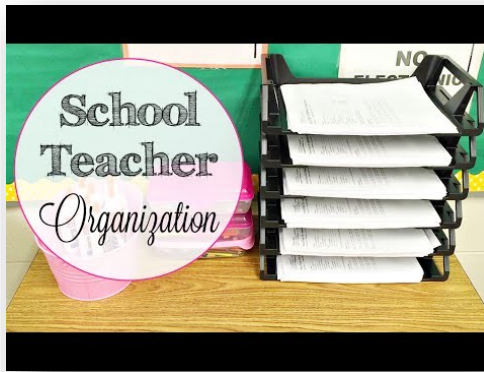
