Dental Programs and Services in Hamilton

Healthy Smiles Ontario

Your child may be eligible for free dental care. The Healthy Smiles Ontario program pays the cost of regular dental services. This program is for children & youth under 18 years of age from lower-income families in need of support. Even if you have dental insurance you may be eligible for Healthy Smiles Ontario. Public Health Services Community Preventive Clinics

Free dental screenings, preventive dental services and dental health information are available in the community for children and youth under 18 years of age. Call the Preventive Services line at 905-546-2424 ext. 5369 for more information.

Public Health Services Downtown Dental Clinic

Children enrolled in the Healthy Smiles Ontario Program (HSO), can be seen in the clinic. If your child is NOT already enrolled in HSO and you have a low income, call us to book a screening.

Adults can apply to get dental treatment at the Public Health Services Dental Clinic. You may qualify if:

- You do not have dental insurance
- You have low income
- You live in the Hamilton area

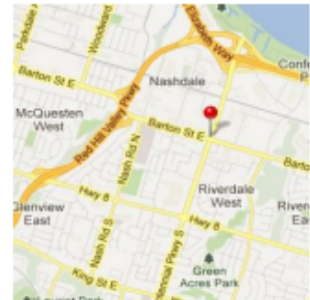

Dear Parents, Guardians and Caregivers,

I have been informed by members of the school community of possible coyote sightings recently on our shared space with the park/woods around us.

Neither myself or school staff have witnessed any coyotes during the school day, however, I wanted to share this information with you as a precaution.

According to the City of Hamilton's website, if you or your children encounter a coyote, please take the following steps to protect yourself:

- * Stay calm if a coyote approaches you and wait until they move on.
- * Shout, clap your hands together or make a loud noise to scare coyotes away.
- * Tell your children to stay away from coyotes and other wildlife.
- * Call Animal Services at 905-574-3433 to report injured or dead wildlife.
