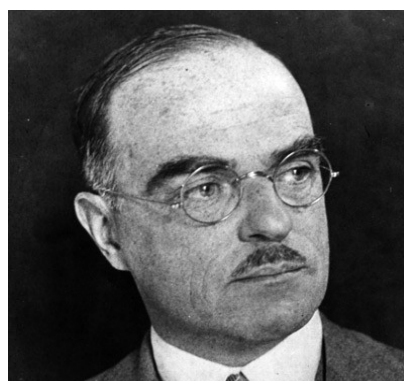


### About the Director **KELLY DANIELS**

(April 17, 1897 – December 7, 1975)

An American playwright and dramatist, he received three Pulitzer Prizes, one for his novel *The Bridge of San Luis Rey* and two for his plays *Our Town* and *The Skin of Our Teeth*. *Our Town* is a three-act play. It is a character story about an average town's citizens in the early twentieth century as depicted through their everyday lives.
