COOTES HOME AND SCHOOL ASSOCIATION CLASS PARENT REPRESENTATIVE: VOLUNTEER JOB DESCRIPTION:

BASIC RESPONSIBILITIES:

- A Class Parent/Guardian rep's primary purpose is to help Cootes Paradise Home and School Association pass information from Association meetings to parents and guardians in a particular classroom to keep all parents/guardians in the loop about the great work being done by the Home and School Association.
- The Class Parent/Guardian rep is expected to attend Cootes Paradise Home and School Association meetings and keep class parents/guardians up to date about Association events and reach out when the Home and School needs help from our community.
- Class Parent/Guardian reps connect with the parents/guardians in this class and, in doing so, continue to build community at Cootes Paradise Elementary.

OPTIONAL RESPONSIBILITIES (DEPENDING UPON THE SPECIFIC CLASS PARENT REPRESENTATIVE AND/OR CLASSROOM TEACHER):

- A Class Parent/Guardian rep may compile a list of class parent/guardian contact information, given with permission, to class parents/guardians for play-dates and birthday parties.
- A Class Parent/Guardian rep can assist a classroom teacher solicit parent/guardian volunteers for specific classroom activities, such as assisted reading or field trips, or specific supplies required by the classroom teacher from parents/ guardians in order to execute a classroom activity (i.e. Kleenex boxes for model-making)
- A Class Parent/Guardian rep can build community by organizing class parent/guardian/family events, such as picnics or socials to be enjoyed by the classroom community.

ACTIVITIES NOT ALLOWED:

- A Class Parent/Guardian rep is not allowed to pass along contact information for another parent or guardian unless explicit permission is given.
- A Class Parent/Guardian rep is not permitted to give unsolicited parenting advice to classroom parents or guardians at any time.
