



## **MARCH BREAK COP CAMP 2017**

**Camp One - March 13<sup>th</sup>- 14<sup>th</sup> / Camp Two - March 15<sup>th</sup>- 16<sup>th</sup>  
9am to 4pm daily**

Hamilton Police Service is hosting Cop Camp in the East End Station gymnasium, located at 2825 King St. E, Hamilton. Two separate camps are divided by age: 9 & 10 year olds attend on March 13<sup>th</sup>-14<sup>th</sup> (Mon/Tues) and 11 & 12 year olds attend on March 15<sup>th</sup>-16<sup>th</sup> (Wed/Thurs). Children must arrive daily by 9am and must be picked-up by a parent or guardian at 4pm sharp. Children with an interest in policing, and children who would benefit from positive interaction with police officers will find the camp entertaining and rewarding. Children are engaged through physical activity, interactive lesson plans and presentations. The camp includes police presentations by K-9, Mounted Patrol Unit and Emergency Response Unit (SWAT). Children will participate in a wide variety of fun games and basic fitness challenges. There is a bullying component, coping with peer pressure, and bicycle safety is also covered.

Both camps are filled on a "first come, first serve basis." Parents **MUST** complete **ALL 3** attached forms (Registration Form, Waiver Form & Photo/Video Release Form) **AND** submit payment (**\$20.00 cheque**) to be officially registered.

**The registration deadline is Friday February 24<sup>th</sup>, 2017.** Please register quickly to ensure your child's spot at the camp (maximum 40 children per camp). **Additional instructions are on the forms.**

The cost is \$20 per child, which includes a camp T-shirt, morning & afternoon snacks, prizes and a pizza luncheon on the final day (second day) of camp. Campers are responsible for their own lunch on the first day of camp.
