#### 1. School Organization for September

- 2. Tentative staffing assignments for next year will be outlined at the end of August. We may have to address retirements, promotions, leaves, moves, placement committee assignments and positions determined by system staffing situations. Over the summer, additional circumstances could come into play where positions could change. We will keep you informed. At this time, we will not be accepting any individual teacher requests for next year. However, if you have a sound educational reason for requesting a specific class placement we will be accepting these requests in writing to the office only until May 9, 2016. All requests will be considered but are not guaranteed.
- 3. The end of the school year is only a few weeks away. Rest assured, any unused funds in your School Cash Online MyWallet account will continue to be available to make purchases at the start of the school year in September. For parents and guardians who have already registered on School Cash Online, you will not need to re enter your child's PIN codes after the initial set up, even if your child is moving on to another HWDSB school.
