Transition Advisory Committee (Terms of Reference) – Version 2 - Revised

The creation of a Transition Advisory committee with a number of different sub-committees would make the best use of community and administrative resources.

Transition Advisory Committee - March 2013- June 2015

The committee's mandate would be to provide advice on program delivery in the two-campus model. The two-campus model is expected to be in place until the final transition to the Governor's Road campus is complete.

The committee will review program delivery models and provide input regarding the implementation of the selected model. This will include activities to assist students to adjust to a two-campus program delivery model.

The committee will provide advice on the presentations and communications to the student body of each school including elementary schools.

The committee will develop a communication plan to share information with the greater community.

The committee will provide implementation advice on the Board's plan for the renewal of the Governor's Road campus.

The committee will also provide advice on the closure of Parkside and the final transition of students to the Governor's Road campus.

The committee will provide advice on the "stepping down" of Highland and the creation of the next Dundas Secondary school.

This committee will also play a role in the school naming process in communicating to the school (in accordance with Board Policy 7.18).
