**4. Staff Report-**

Math dept- EQAO testing for grade 9's June 9th and 11th. In regular classrooms- booklets approx. hour long. Grade 12 exams- start June 16th. Direction about preparing for the move to West Campus. Evaluation of EQAO- counts for 15% of their mark exam 15% and term work 70%.

NPDL(New Pedagogies for Deep Learning)- group of math teachers- Deep learning - give students a choice- get more than math out of it-build a bigger understanding. 6 C's are the focus- citizenship, creativity, critical thinking, character, communication, collaboration. Find a trend to connect to the math. Linear or non linear relationship. Relate math to real life. Professional development piece worthwhile- want to make it better for next years grade nines.

**5. Principal's Report-**

Staffing update- staffed for 66 and 65 next year by semester. Last year we were given 2 additional classes- we are losing one teacher next year- surplus staff-lowest person on seniority list. Had a retirement, one year exchange- permanent therefore only one position lost.

Timetables- 95% of kids got their first choice, department heads to review and staff the courses. Guidance counsellors review the conflicts. Timetables will be given by the end of the school year. New grade nines will receive theirs in August with the welcome letter.

PISA- Program international student assessment. DVSS was chosen to participate randomly- 40 kids will be writing an assessment test. ID if student not able to write the test- only one refusal by a parent. An indicator of how kids have done from JK to grade 9. We are usually ranked 4th or 5th in the world. Math, science and literacy looked at on an international scale.

Literacy test: online practice test. Kids who would not normally do the online test on their own. Tomorrow and May 21st.

Positive School Climate: Survey to be done and potentially repeated next year on our own. It is legislated by the govt.

Final Exam Schedule Online: Almost all exams are in the room the course is currently in- unless it is otherwise noted.
