GRADE 9 IPAD ROLLOUT

Welcome Gr. 9 Gryphons! As you embark on your high school career, early in the semester we will be leveraging digital technology to deepen your learning. All Grade 9 students will receive mini iPads as a tool to support your learning. Prior to the distribution of the devices we will ensure you and your parents are aware of the responsibilities and expectations for use and help you to develop digital citizenship skills. Throughout your courses, you will have the opportunity to use the DVSS mini iPad to access the digital world to support your problem solving, inquiry and ability to critically analyze the vast world of information available to you.

1. DVSS TIME SCHEDULES

Dundas Valley will operate on a **ROTATING DAY 1 and DAY 2 schedule**. 3. LUNCH AREAS

We ask that you please obey the school rules and do not block the egress to school; this means that there can be *no eating or sitting in the school hallways* (unless it is a designated bench area). PLEASE EAT either in the cafeteria or in designated teacher classrooms. *THERE IS PLENTY OF ROOM TO ACCOMMODATE THE SCHOOL POPULATION TO HAVE LUNCH*. Please use the garbage bin to discard your garbage. Help us to help you...keep the school looking clean and bright so that it is reflective of you!

4. "NO PARKING" AREAS

When parents are waiting to pick up students, it is important to be aware of our signage indicating parking restrictions. Please ONLY pick up your student in the <u>student parking lot</u> – do not wait along the driveway leading into the staff parking lot or outside the back doors of the circle (west end of school).

Signage has been clearly posted from the front entrance of the school toward the rear of the circle wing of the school which indicates that there must be no parking at all due to fire regulations.

Please be advised that, if necessary, bylaw officers will be called to come and issue tickets if these areas are not kept clear of all vehicles.

5. TRANSPORTATION/ BUSING

All courtesy transportation applications will be date and time stamped, so that it is a first come first served basis pending bus seats.

6. SCHOOL COUNCIL

The first meeting of the 2016 - 2017 School Council will be held on **Tuesday, SEPTEMBER 20**th in the Learning Commons at 6:30 p.m. At this meeting our School Council election will take place. Please go to the DVSS website to review the DVSS SCHOOL COUNCIL BY-LAWS. We would LOVE to have as many parents involved in our School Council so that together we can colead and co-create a community school reflective of our needs and wants and created with teachers and parents working side by side. Please come and join our AMAZING parents as we see all parents/caregivers as a partner to our students' education.

7. LOCKERS

Lockers will be assigned by your PERIOD 1 teacher. You must bring in a combination lock, in which you show your teacher the combination and open the lock in front of your teacher. ONCE you open your combination lock, your PERIOD 1 teacher will assign you a locker. SO PLEASE NOTE that you MUST ONLY take a locker that is assigned to you. IF you take a locker that is assigned to someone else, you will be asked to remove the lock or your lock will be cut off. The goal is to support you in being close to your first period class. IF you wish to change your locker, then come and see a VP who will re-assign you another locker. PLEASE FOLLOW THIS PROCESS. It will make your life and those who work in the school a lot easier.

8. ONLINE FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

With the support of School Cash Online, we're making paying for school related expenses easier. You can now make online payments through our school website or using your credit card. This is a win-win by making it safer and more efficient for everyone by reducing the amount of cash and cheques coming into our school. While parents will still have the option to send cash or cheques for school related expenses, we encourage you to get on board with our new service and register today and begin receiving notifications by email. If your child is moving to another HWDSB school

9. TIMETABLES

Please note that all timetable changes will start the week of September 6th.

Grade 9 students will receive their timetables on August 31 at Smart Start Day.

Grade 10-12 timetables will be with students' homeroom teachers. Homeroom class lists will be posted the first day of school in the cafeteria. Students can find their names and go to homeroom to pick up their timetables.

GUIDANCE COUNSELLORS

The Guidance Office and counsellors will be available Monday, August 29 - Friday, September 2 from 8:30 am - 1:30 pm for new registrations. Counsellors may also be available for timetable conflicts and changes if time permits: students may drop in to see if they can be assisted between registration appointments, or wait until the first week of school to make timetable changes. The best thing to do is make all the changes you want to your timetable ASAP, so that you do not miss any class time.

10. STUDENT PARKING

Student parking is limited to the parking lot next to the tennis court. Bringing your vehicle to school is a privilege; therefore, please respect all the vehicles around you and any pedestrians who may be nearby. PLEASE avoid speeding and driving recklessly...your life and the lives of those around you matter. IF you are found being careless in your vehicle, this administration will ask you NOT TO BRING YOUR CAR ON SCHOOL PROPERTY. We state this seriously so that you can respect the lives of those around you.

Also, please respect all NO PARKING areas. Signage is in place and must be followed. If necessary, we will request bylaw officers to come and ticket those who park in restricted areas.
