#### **Examination Routines**

- 1. Students are responsible to check the examination schedule to ensure that they have the correct date, time and location for their subject evaluations. All medical notes need to be brought to the Main Office at Dundas Valley within 24 hours of the exam.

- 4. Students are not allowed for any reason to communicate with other students during an examination. Non-compliance may result in a loss of examination marks.
- 5. Cell Phones/Electronic Devices Absolutely <u>NO</u> personal electronic devices are to be on or in sight during the examination. Please <u>ensure</u> all cell phones are turned off.
- 6. Students must check with their teacher to determine the length of their final evaluation. Students MUST remain in their exam for a minimum of 75 minutes.
