Examination Routines

- 1. Students are responsible to check the examination schedule to ensure that they have the correct date, time and location for their subject evaluations. A student who misses an examination for any reason, other than a documented medical or bereavement absence, may be assigned a mark of zero. All medical notes need to be brought to the Main Office at Dundas Valley within 24 hours of the exam.
- 2. Students are responsible for arriving at the examination location by 8:30 am for attendance purposes. It is suggested that students arrive at least 5 minutes early. No additional time will be provided for students arriving late to the exam. Specific room assignments for exams will be posted by classroom teachers
- 3. Students are responsible for arriving with the supplies (pen, pencil, eraser, ruler, calculator, etc.) necessary to write the examination. Please come prepared. Please return texts borrowed to classroom teachers.
- 4. Students are not allowed for any reason to communicate with other students during an examination. Non-compliance may result in a loss of examination marks.
- 5. Cell Phones/Electronic Devices Absolutely <u>NO</u> personal electronic devices are to be on or in sight during the examination. Please <u>ensure</u> all cell phones are turned off.
- 6. Students must check with their teacher to determine the length of their final evaluation. Students MUST remain in their exam for a minimum of 75 minutes.
- 7. The library and resource room will **NOT BE OPEN** during regular exam times for quiet study. Students needing a place to work and study should report to the cafeteria.
