- Location: Michelangelo Banquet Centre, 1555 Upper Ottawa Street, Hamilton
- Eligibility: Participation in the ceremony is contingent on students meeting the requirements of a Ministry OSSD or Certificate. Please assist our preparation and organization of the ceremony by making every effort to follow timelines below.
- Fee: A \$55 Ceremony fee pays for items such as the hall, programs, gown rental, caps for grads to keep, and a professional 5x7 photo of the graduate receiving their diploma. Financial assistance is available if needed see your guidance counsellor for details.
