Central Mountain, have your say!

For five months, the Central Mountain Elementary Accommodation Review has involved working and public meetings at which a committee of stakeholders developed an accommodation scenario for Cardinal Heights, Eastmount Park, Franklin Road, G.L. Armstrong, Linden Park, Pauline Johnson, Queensdale and Ridgemount schools.

Reviews are important to make sure we are efficiently using available space to accommodate students as long-term demand for enrolment changes. The Accommodation Review Committee (ARC) is comprised of parents, teachers and community members.

Important dates in this process are approaching – please take note and have your say.

Step 1 – Reports are presented

Monday, March 24 at Hamilton City Hall Council Chambers

Special Board Meeting (following Standing Committee, which starts at 6 p.m.)

The Accommodation Review Committee presents its report with recommendations to the Board of Trustees. After reviewing the ARC Report, Board staff presents the Director's Report with recommendations to the Board of Trustees within 30 days.

Step 2 – Delegations are heard

A special public meeting will be held to receive public input from delegations regarding the Director's Report and the ARC Report.

A Board of Trustees meeting will be held to make a decision regarding the recommendations in the ARC Report and Director's Report.

Step 4 – Trustees ratify decision

Monday, June 16 at Hamilton City Hall Council Chambers at 6 p.m.

Regular Board Meeting

A Board of Trustees meeting will be held to ratify decisions for Central Mountain, East Hamilton and West Flamborough.
