

Student Absences

In keeping with our Arrivals Check policy, we would like to remind all parents/guardians to <u>call the office to</u> advise of any absences for your child **BEFORE 9:30 AM**. If your child is absent for more than one day, we <u>still require a phone call each morning.</u> Our automated call system begins making calls for any unexplained absences at 9:55. If your child is going to arrive after 9:30, please call to let us know the approximate arrival time. By letting us know your child will be absent/late, we know that your child is safe and you avoid the repeated automated calls.

If you know in advance that your child will be absent (i.e. for medical appointments, vacation, etc.), please inform the office beforehand so that we may enter the attendance. This also saves you from having to call us on a busy day!
