PARENT VOLUNTEERS FOR CLASS TRIPS

Parent volunteers play an important role on our class trips as the HWDSB requires specific adult/child ratios (depending on the age of the students) for all off site excursions. If you are interested in volunteering for your child's end of year class trip, you must have a police check. Police checks are only valid with the HWDSB for 3 years. If your police check is older than 1 year but less than 3, you are required to complete an Offence Declaration. Please contact the office for forms or questions.

Vulnerable Sector Police Checks for volunteers have a fee of \$25 and take 30 days to process.

Please note that teachers only need a certain number of volunteers and may not be able to accommodate all parents wanting to help with the trip due to cost and space on the bus.
