Grade 1– 8 Students 1.6 km

All other students must request courtesy transportation. Because of limited seats courtesy transportation will be first offered to grade 1 students.

For any bussing requirements please come into the Main Office and obtain a Courtesy Transportation Form that will need to be completed and then approved.

Courtesy bussing is NOT available for the start of the school year. You will be contacted once transportation has finalized their student numbers and routes which is mid to late October.
