### PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

January has been a month full of celebrations! Over the course of the month and wrapping up this week, we have had 43 IPRC Annual Reviews. It has been so exciting to sit together with parents, care givers and community partners and celebrate the success of our students and make plans to move their learning forward. In many of our meetings, we were supported by our wonderful HWDSB system support staff, which included such roles as the Psychological Services, Intensive Support Services (formerly the ASD and ACT Teams), Speech and Language Pathologists, Orientation and Mobility, Blind and Low Vision and our Special Education Consultant. Together, we reviewed each student's identification, placement, discussed transition plans and programming. As a result of every meeting, the committee recorded recommendations that will be addressed over the next school year. Another component of our meeting focused on reaching 'out' into the community and 'ahead' past their 21st birthday. As we look 'out and ahead' it is very important to ensure transition plans are being developed well in advance. Such planning includes being registered with **CONTACT Hamilton** and connecting with the Developmental Services Ontario (DSO). If you have any questions about either resource or this process, please contact your child's classroom teacher or myself.

Over the next few months you may hear about some new people in your child's classes. Glenwood Special Day School has a strong partnership with **Mohawk**College and their Educational Assistant Program. Three Mohawk students will be doing their final placements here with us. We have found that this is a wonderful learning experience for those students and a great opportunity for our students to engage with other caring adults.

Please save February 22 in your family calendar, as we will be having our Annual Family Fun Night! As in previous years, this is a student friendly event specially

designed for your child. It is a cost free night full of interactive activities and games designed by our students and staff, special treats, popcorn and door prizes. Our evening runs from 6-8 pm with a concert at 7 pm by **James Ferris** from the Corktown! James and his friends, including **Gator Gus**, will get everyone celebrating! We are looking forward to **Family Fun Night!** Come one and come all! We are excited to welcome many of our alumni families and graduates back to Glenwood for this night as well.

# Keeping Active with Room 11!

Recently, the students have put their newly learned skills into action as they participated in the first part of a Walking Fitness program. Staff and students watch the fitness program on the Smart Board and all participate together.

### Room 3 Rocks MyGaze!

The activities described below are currently favourites of the guys in room 3, who all demonstrate a terrific and contagious sense of humour. Each of the programs has a visual and auditory response. These activities also help the students understand cause and effect.

Bottles: In this activity, there are a variety of green glass bottles of assorted sizes and shapes on 3 shelves. When the student makes eye contact, the bottle explodes, and then a new bottle replaces it. The sound of breaking glass is heard.

Xylophone: In this musical activity, there is a colourful animated xylophone on the screen. When the student makes eye contact with one of the xylophone keys, a musical note plays and motion lines emanate from the musical instrument.

#### What's Up Room 12?

Everyday we ask each other, "What did you do last night?" The students in room 12 have an array of answers - went up and down on the escalators at Jackson Square Mall, listened to some music, bounced on my yoga ball, looked out the window to see the cars, bounced my basketball or played with my sensory toys. The students also have some preferred activities that are dear to them - listening to music while wearing my weighted blanket, playing with my beads, looking up special occasions on the iPad and lastly working.

The students are really looking forward to Valentine's Day!

#### Busy Busy in Room 4!

Room 4 students and staff have been busy using our MyGaze technology. This is an exciting programme with many new skills to learn. Each day students have the opportunity to improve their stamina while learning to focus their gaze on various objects on-screen with cause and effect programmes. Our long term goal, once trained, will be for our students to be able to access communication programmes to better tell us their wants and needs.

Our class painted their own t-shirts for our New Year's dinner and with a few splatters of paint here and there, they turned out well.

At the very end of January we have been working on our 90s music video for the upcoming Glenwood 1990s Video Production.
