Principal's Message

Thank you to all of the staff and students for their understanding and patience during re-organization. Congratulations to Miss Jones (one of our JK/SK teachers) who was an occasional teacher at Hess on an LTO and obtained a permanent position with the Board, unfortunately not at our school. I would like to take this opportunity to welcome Mrs. Bezemer, Mr. Soucie and Ms. Berdula to our staff. Mrs. Bezemer is teaching our new grade 2/3 class, Mr. Soucie is supporting learning throughout the school, and Ms. Berdula is the new LTO in our JK/SK class. As we approach November, teachers have now had ample opportunity to assess our students' learning and needs. Numeracy continues to be a focus at Hess St. We encourage parents to engage their children in 'number talk'. For example, look for opportunities for students to count in multiples, such as 3, 6, 9, 12, 15 when eating grapes or crackers. Another example might be counting forwards (1, 2, 3...) or backwards (10, 9, 8...) while climbing up or going down stairs. Whatever the level, conversation involving numbers is a wonderful way to demonstrate the value of mathematics and develop a love for it.
