Hess St has a New Schedule

This year we will be having a new schedule which involves two nutrition breaks during the day. Each break will consist of 20 min for students to have their snack/lunch, as well as 20 min for outdoor activity. This will slightly extend the length of the school day. ALL students will be required to remain at school during the 1st nutrition break. During the 2nd nutrition break, students may leave to go home for lunch IF the lunch form is signed or if a note from home is provided for the day. As always, students Gr 5 and under should not be left at school unsupervised before or after school.

SCHOOL-CASH ONLINE

Student Fees

Hess St Elementary and the Hamilton-Wentworth District School believes that students are entitled to an education that ensures they achieve their full potential and that all students must be able to participate in all aspects of their school experience regardless of personal economic barriers that exist. In some cases, fees are requested to enhance or supplement regular programming. For example, fees may be requested for Gr 8 graduation, field trips and team/tryout fees. Breakfast Program/Pizza Day/Milk

Our Breakfast program at Hess will start the week of Sept 12. Bins are provided in each classroom in the morning which provides nutritious food for any students in the class who would like something to eat when they come in. We have had a lot of students sign up to volunteer to help with the program and are so thankful to have such wonderful students who are willing to help out. We could not do it without you. Pizza day will start September 15th. Pizza is \$1.00/slice and students can order from their teacher on Thursday mornings. We will also continue to sell milk for \$1.00 and more information will come home on that shortly.

Wesley Before/After School Programs

As in previous years, Wesley is offering an after school care program which runs from 2:50—5:00 at no cost. Registration for this program will start Tuesday at the end of the day in the school foyer and is on a first-come/first-serve basis. They can have up to 30 children and once they are full you can fill out an application and go on a waiting list if you wish. Wesley also has a before and after school care program where your children can enjoy an interactive program that includes a variety of physical activities, crafts and games. A free snack is provided daily. This program is also open during all P.A. Days and other school breaks. The fees for this program is for before and after kindergarten \$18.00/day, and for before and after school age (grade 1 and up) \$12.00/day. Families may be eligible to receive subsidy.
