Proceedings

Call to Order/ Welcome and Introductions:

Ms. Horton called the meeting to order at 6:17 p.m. All welcomed.

Teacher's Report (Ms. Depew):

FDK and Gr. 1 continue to work and learn with Reading Specialist, Ms. Porterfield.

All staff continue to focus on climate/culture for all students.

Principal's Report:

Renos are in Highview's future: accessibility and a gym expansion. Highview not planned for next summer though. Visual arts, learning commons, outdoor play area all earmarked for next five years.

Some students cannot navigate stairs, so the school needs to improve access.

Kindie Pathway – Superintendent Paul Dennome looked at it; goal is to connect one end to the other. Must keep pushing for it.

Water Fountain (Hydration Station) – Caretaking Area Supervisor wants to connect with us, needs to know who installed it.

Swipe entry at exterior doors, school expense. Will probably install one at the back entrance, hopefully this year, allowing for secure and easy access for staff.

Treasurer's Report:

We have spent a lot of money, but still have \$9,200.00 to spend.

Ms. Noble – list from teachers about equipment bags (mesh bags with sports equipment).

List from Ms. Depew: hula hoops, pylons, 10 scoops/balls, small and large balls, etc.

Ms. Baschiera made a motion at 6:31 to give \$100.00 to each class for equipment. Mr. Merifield amended to \$2,000.00 total. Motion seconded by Ms. Bognar, all in favour.

Ms. Porterfield is leading buying the books for all teachers.

iPad kits are being ordered.

Ms. Noble brought up that Green Team is wondering about the Greenhouse purchase; waiting on approval from the Board. Mr. Pellizzari mentioned that we need to try to spend money raised this year, this year, but this is a big project and may take time. Thank you cards from Green Team handed out to Council.

School Pictures:

Edge Imaging wants to book for next year. Time frame?

Ms. Horton asked if there were any issues. Late pictures: only arrived just before Christmas. If mailed home however, they come earlier. Mr. Pellizzari will book and ensure more timely orders.

PRO Grant Ideas:

Ms. Baschiera suggested a math night: common session, math curriculum, break into groups and do math work with teachers. Math apps recommended and classroom visits.

Ms. Depew suggested a Legoland Night (www.creativeclubinc.com) linked to math. Lego centre table, activities, all in one space. RSVP event and only 175 can attend. Parents and students both enjoyed it at her children's school. Mr. Merifeld said we might need two nights.

Ms. Bognar reminded Council that Ms. Corbin-Harper had previously suggested a Games Night.

Mr. Merifield recommended a Movie Night, however Ms. Bognar brought up whether that would qualify for the grant.

Artists could be brought in, having a different artist in each room.

Inquiry Night

Ms. Bognar has already registered, deadline is in May for next year.

Mr. Pellizzari – Jump 2 Math Night for the younger ones, mats on floor, rolling to numbers, \$997.00 approx.

Ms. Horton asked if we can just call it a "Math Night" on the grant application, and streamline it later. Ms. Bognar to look into it.

Mr. Pellizzari asked parents how much work they want to do for this. Perhaps better to have an outside group come in, rather than have parents and teachers run it.

Wellness focus allowed: Zumba, dancing, etc.

Goal is to have people engaged in schools.

Ms. Baschiera – Open House

Mr. Merifield asked if twins need to be separated or can they stay in the same class? Case by case, parent request, can be separated or stay together.

Open House date TBA, Mr. Pellizzari asked for a recommendation for the date. Education Week: May 7th – 11th. Ms. Baschiera would like it later in the day.

Ms. Bognar – Brent and Sarah Anti-Bullying Magic Show will be next Wednesday. Seven classes are participating in the Poster Contest.
