Moving or Moved:

If you know that you will be moving over the summer, or if you have moved over the course of the school year, please notify the office as soon as possible. This really helps us to keep our records accurate and to know exactly the numbers of students within each grade/classroom.

Please note that although Highview School is not closed to "Out of Catchment" students, parents/guardians must follow the proper steps regarding this. According to the HWDSB Out of Catchment Policy, anyone residing in another school's catchment area will need to register at their home school for September and complete an Out Of Catchment request form for Highview if requesting to remain. Out of catchment requests will be considered in late September, and decisions will be based upon space available within the requested grade(s).

Safe Welcome Protocol:

As you know, the HWDSB has initiated a Safe Welcome Program. The program supports a welcoming learning environment by ensuring that parents and other authorized visitors can access elementary schools while keeping students and staff safe. At our school, all exterior school doors will be locked during the instructional day, and visitors must access the school via the main entrance. Please be reminded that the front entrance is equipped with a video/intercom access system which is to be used to gain access. Once granted entry, all visitors must report directly to the office. Anyone needing to travel beyond the office will be asked to sign in and to wear a visitor's sticker. Thanks in advance for your cooperation in keeping all of our students and staff safe!
