Your child's safety is of great concern to us. The school parking lot at drop off and pick up presents a great challenge for us in ensuring student safety. Parents are not permitted to drop off or pick up their child from the main parking lot. This presents a significant hazard as the majority of our children leave campus via the front of the building, bus traffic and unauthorized parent vehicles are creating a very unsafe situation for our students. If you must pick up your child from school, we urge you to use Eastwood St. or Melvin Avenue for this purpose. Melvin Avenue is a very light traffic road, adjacent to our playground with limited parking/ stopping restrictions. We ask that parents picking up students with a vehicle meet their child on Melvin Ave. A crossing guard is in place on Melvin to further ensure student safety.

Our school website has the ability for each parent to subscribe for information and updates. WE ARE A NUT SENSITIVE SCHOOL

Parents are asked to carefully read labels of all food items that are brought to school to make sure that they have no trace of nuts or nut products. Many products now carry a clearly marked "Nut Free" logo. In an effort to keep all our children safe we ask that if you are sending in treats to school on special occasion days (class parties or birthdays) that they be store purchased labeled "nut Free" products only. Although we really appreciate the home baked goods it is too difficult for us to ensure the safety of these food items for the variety of food allergies present in the school.

We appreciate your cooperation in providing a safe learning/work environment for our students and staff.

Procedures for Access & Visitors

- **1.** Require that all visitors (parents/guardians, volunteers, etc.) only access our school through the main doors of the school which will be locked and require visitors to be buzzed in by office staff.
- **2**. Require that all visitors to the school MUST sign in the "Visitor Book" located in the main office.
- **3.** Require that all parents/guardians who are picking up children to leave for an appointment must sign them out at the office so that we have a record of their children going home with them.
- **4**. Require that all volunteers have police checks and wear the Identification Badges that have been provided by the school at all times when on school property functioning as a volunteer.
- **5**. Require that parents/guardians who have notes, homework, supplies, lunches etc. report to the main office. One of the most important learning factors for children is the amount of "time on task"

(learning time) that they receive "free from distractions". Thus, we ask that we honour teachers teaching time and students learning time by not interrupting classes during the instructional day. Your child's lunch, etc. will be given to your child by the office staff at the next break in instructional time (nutrition breaks).

6. Require that parents/guardians who are picking up or dropping off children during the day report to the office to sign their children in or out.

Uniforms

Hillcrest school is a uniform school. All of our students are required to wear a uniform top each day. If you have yet to make arrangements to purchase uniforms from our uniform supplier JML (located at 95 Parkdale Ave) please do so as soon as possible. Students who come to school without uniform are re-directed to the office by the classroom teacher and students are provided with a shirt to borrow for the day. Please make every effort to ensure that your child is in uniform each and everyday. If you should have any questions or concerns regarding the uniform top please feel free to contact the school directly for any assistance.

Our office staff must contact the home of each and every student marked absent as part of our safe school policy and we thank you for your continued co-operation in helping to minimize the number of calls we must make.



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Parking

In order to keep our students safe while on Campus we ask that families who drop students off **use only Melvin Ave or Eastwood St.** as the drop zone. Not the school parking lot' Only staff vehicles and buses should enter the parking lot between the hours of 8:45–9:15am and again between 3:00 pm and 3:45pm as these are the times when our students are exiting campus, many of them down the front walkways of the school adjacent to the parking lot and driveways. Supervision Before and After School

Please be aware that the school play ground is not supervised in the morning until 8:45 am. This means that children who arrive before this time are unfortunately not supervised by a school official and therefore we are not able to ensure your child's safety before this time. We have had many students of all ages arriving before 8:45 and this has presented challenges, as sometimes conflict occurs before supervision is present making it difficult for us to intervene and problem solve in a timely fashion. Additionally the school is not open to all parents before bell times. Should you have the need to speak with your child's teacher please come into the office to make an appointment at a time convenient to you and the staff will make every effort to accommodate your request. Please do not walk to classrooms as this presents a safety concern to all students and staff.

Afternoon dismissal also presents some growing concerns for us. The bell goes at 3:20 and therefore all students walking home must be picked up by 3:20. We do provide supervision until 3:35 outside if you are running late. Please make arrangements to be at the school on time as we can not be housing students in the office while we search for a parent or caregiver. Some students are being directed by parents to wait in the office until they arrive and we are not always available to supervise students. Please make every effort to have a caregiver get your child on time.
