

Holbrook School Council Meeting Minutes: November 14th, 2012

1. Welcome and Call to Order: 6:30pm
2. Approval of previous minutes: Heather requested Wendy Workman's name be added to attendees. Jennifer will do and resend. Heather motions to accept minutes included amendment, Marcia seconded. **Passed.**
3. Principal's Report
 - a. Curriculum
 - LLI – Levelled Literacy Instruction – used in small groups
 - Primary – LLI groups in place – “Class Act” for students that need extra support
 - Juniors – guided practise – literacy groups
 - Focus on “shared reading: - had consultant come in and present to staff and share resources
 - Math – Numeracy – building up Math Manipulatives – resources for “hands on” learning – inservices for grades 3 and 6 teachers – a new resource. This will eventually be rolled out to all grades
 - Science – would like \$300 for equipment – suggest that we share the cost, with \$150 from council funds and \$150 from school funds – this was not discussed or voted on at the meeting
 - Progress reports come home Tuesday, November 20th
 - Parent Teacher conferences – Thurs eve and Friday – an opportunity to review the strengths and “next steps” in the report
 - Grade 4 Canada Wide Achievement Assessment testing coming up – provides a baseline and screens for gifted students as well
 - b. Environment.
 - Hallowe'en parade – a wonderful sight, Cathie really enjoyed the experience
 - Remembrance Day assembly – quiet, respectful and meaningful
 - Bulldogs Game – loud! With lots of enthusiasm
 - Bus Safety Assembly – Thurs Nov 29th combined with Entertainment book prize assembly
 - The Peace Tree assembly on Dec 3rd in a.m – video presentation, showing celebration of different faiths. There will be a display in the front foyer, Madame is bringing in something from Diwali for example.
 - Scrooge – put on by Grds 5/6 classes on Dec 20th – time not confirmed
 - Lockdown – letter to parents going home. Handed out at meeting. Drills for this need to be done twice a year. Fire drills done 6 times a year. Cathie will visit each class afterwards to discuss any concerns students may have
 - Synrevoice – service that is available to some schools – message can be created that is then used to call each child's home. Cathie investigating possibility for our school, but it does cost money, so may not be available
