Parking Lot- Please READ

At Janet Lee we are very lucky to have a parking lot and Kiss & Ride on site. As we grow, these areas become very busy during the morning and after school.

Students who live within walking distance are encouraged to walk to and from school.

If you have to drop your student off at school it is important that you follow the proper Kiss & Ride procedures.

If you are not going to park, but just drop your child off you must use the kiss and ride (not the parking lot). When using the Kiss & Ride parents are to let their children out of the car, ensure they are safely walking to school and then proceed out of the parking lot, allowing a consistent flow of traffic.
