

Once HWDSB has been notified of a heat event, information will be posted on our website and the following precautionary steps will be taken for students:

- Limit physical outdoor activities
- * Ensure access to water
- Close drapes and blinds
- * Move students through cooler areas of the school
- * Monitor students for symptoms of heat stress



What Happens Next Year?

With the support of School Cash Online, we're making paying for school related expenses easier.

You can now make online payments through our school website or by using your credit card. This is a win/win by making it safer and more efficient for everyone by reducing the amount of cash and cheques coming into our school.

While parents will still have the option to send cash or cheques for school related expenses, we encourage you to get on board with our new service and register today and begin receiving notifications by email.

If your child is moving to another HWDSB school in September, by registering now, your payment history and registration will move with you to the next school. The end of the school year is only a few weeks away. Rest assured, any unused funds in your School Cash Online MyWallet account will continue to be available to make purchases at the start of the school year in September.

For parents/guardians who have already registered on School Cash Online, you will not need to re-enter your child's PIN codes after the initial setup, even if your child is moving on to another HWDSB school.
