Principal's Report (Mr. Brian Patton):

- Student population 2017 = 705 students;
- School Reorganization only 6 students in grade 1 will be affected in both FI and grade 1 Eng.
- Adventure Works Leadership Program grades 7 and 8's teambuilding with a focus on positive culture and school climate both English and FI students participated in the free onsite activity.
- New Hope Bike Smart Ride Program: For all grade 4-6 students, the program will be coming to Lawfield
- Strategic Directions focus at Lawfield continue to be 75% grade 1 students reading by end of
 grade 1; improvement in math will be the focus for the PD day with Health and Safety in the
 afternoon.
