
Upper Bus/Traffic Lanes and Parking Update: A huge thanks to so many parents who navigate our parking lots with care and adherence to our requests! Safety of our students is key. Please remember to only park in designated parking spots, or on the street. The Fire Department and By-Law office have re-positioned some important "Fire Zone" signs along the left hand side of the driveway that exits our school at the upper level. Some parents have been parking here at the end of the day (opposite the Kiss and Drop Zone), and I wanted to advise that you are not to park in this Fire lane. Fines are significant should by-law be in the area, and I would hate for anyone to get caught in a bad situation. On a good note however, I have finally (after over a year) been able to reach agreement with the city to remove the signs on the school side of Kennard that state "Bus Loading Zone –no parking", etc. I'm not positive when the signs will be removed, but I have been advised that they will come down. Once that is the case, there will be more parking available to parents on Kennard, just in front of the school.
