Get Ready - Practice your route to school and point out any dangers to your children.

Get Set - Teach your children the Four Steps to safely cross the street.

- Stop and Look both ways
- Listen for traffic
- Wait until the street is clear and all traffic has stopped


• Make eye contact with drivers to make sure they have seen you **And Remember** - Always walk on the sidewalk. Children under 9 need supervision when they cross the street. Children should walk to school with a parent, a sibling or a responsible friend.

School Bus Safety - Talk to your children about the school bus rules

- Don't let your children arrive too early they may wander.
- Tell them to come straight home when they get off the bus.
- Have a plan if your child misses the bus
- Remind your children to find a seat and stay seated until the driver says they can get off
- When getting off the bus, remind your children to take all their belongings. One backpack is easy to remember
- Teach your children to walk out away from the front of the bus when the red lights are flashing; that way the driver can see them.

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Life Threatening Allergies

Safe School Procedures...

Our School Community continues to work together ensuring a safe school. One of the goals is to educate and heighten awareness of necessary safety rules in and around the school. Please remember that the

parking lot is an **out of bounds area** for our students. There is **No Stopping/Parking at ANY time** in the school bus loading area or in the staff parking lot except for parents dropping off or picking up their bildren from the VMCA program. Places be courted up of

children from the YMCA program. Please be courteous of our neighbors at the end of the day by making sure their driveways are not being blocked. Safety of the students is a priority. Thank you for your ongoing support.



Gentle Reminder - you will have noticed that again this year, teachers & support staff are meeting their students outside each morning at 8:55 a.m. on the back playground. This practice will continue throughout the school year. In an attempt to keep the hallways and entry doors congestion free, we are asking that all parents/guardians say good bye to their child(ren) outside each morning. This allows for a safe and orderly entrance into the building.

All students who do not take the bus will be dismissed onto the BACK PLAYGROUND at the 3:15 p.m. dismissal bell. Parents/ guardians will meet students on the back playground to avoid congestion at the front of the school. Thank you for your co-operation in this matter.

School Cash Online

School Cash Online is an easy to use and safe way to pay for your children's school fees. Now, with a few clicks, you can pay for your child's yearbook, class trips and so much more from your own home. All you have to do is register an account, attach your children and in no time you will be able to make payments online. School Cash Online is available at all HWDSB schools.

School Cash Online is an on-line payment service offered through the KEV Group. The KEV Group is Canadian owned and operates its head offices in the Province of Ontario. There are over 9,000 schools using KEV's solutions for managing school bookkeeping across North America.

The School Cash Online website is certified compliant with Payment Card Industry (PCI) Data Security Standards. School Cash Online does not share personal information with any third party. They do not store credit card information on their own web servers, computers or other devices. With the exception of funds loaded into MyWallet, your payment information must be entered every time you checkout.

The KEV Group uses Moneris as the payment processor. Moneris is Canada's largest payment processor, processing over 3 billion credit and debit transactions every year.

To participate in using this service, your child must obtain a one-time PIN code from the school for our secure registration process. If you require a PIN code, please contact the school office. Newly registered grade 1 students will receive their PIN codes a few weeks into the school year.



Safe Welcome Program

This program supports a welcoming learning environment by ensuring that parents and other authorized visitors can access elementary schools while keeping students and staff safe.

Exterior school doors will continue to be locked during the instructional day, and visitors will access the school during school hours via the main entrance.

You will notice that our main entrance is equipped with a video/ intercom access system and signage. The access system allows staff to see and talk with any visitors requesting entry into the school. The system also allows school office staff to electronically release the lock on the door.

Please note that visitors must report to the office for sign-in.

COURTESY TRANSPORTATION

Our office administrators have been working very hard on the organization of our bussing. Once everything is in place and all spots have been confirmed we will begin to offer courtesy transportation. Until then we
