DIPLOMA REQUIREMENTS – 30 CREDITS

18 COMPULSORY CREDITS TO INCLUDE:

THESE 15 CREDITS:

- 4 credits in English (1 credit per grade)*
- 3 credits in mathematics (1 credit in Grade 11 or 12)
- 2 credits in science
- 1 credit in Canadian history
- 1 credit in Canadian geography
- 1 credit in the arts
- 1 credit in health and physical education
- 1 credit in French as a second language
- 0.5 credit in career studies
- 0.5 credit in civics

PLUS ONE CREDIT FROM EACH OF THE FOLLOWING GROUPS:

- Group 1:** One additional credit in English, or French as a second language,** or a Native language, or a classical or an international language, or social sciences and the humanities, or Canadian and world studies, or guidance and career education, or cooperative education***
- Group 2:** One additional credit in health and physical education, or the arts, or business studies, or French as a second language,** or cooperative education****
- Group 3:** One additional credit in science (Grade 11 or 12), or technological education (Grades 9 – 12), or French as a second language,** or computer studies, or cooperative education****

In addition to the compulsory credits, students must complete 12 optional credits†, 40 hours of community involvement, and the provincial literacy requirement.

*A maximum of 3 credits in English as a second language (ESL) or English literacy development (ELD) may be counted towards the 4 compulsory credits in English, but the fourth must be a credit earned for a Grade 12 compulsory English course.

**In groups 1, 2, & 3, a maximum of 2 credits in French as a second language can count as compulsory credits, one from group 1 & one from either group 2 or group 3.

***A maximum of 2 credits in cooperative education can count as compulsory credits.

†The 12 optional credits may include up to 4 credits earned through approved dual credit courses.

PATHWAYS

- Applied courses – lead to C (college) level courses in Grade 11
- Academic courses –lead to M(college/university) or U (university) level courses in Grade 11

Wednesday, January 31, 2018

Every year, school boards across Ontario must submit school year calendars to the Ministry of Education. According to Regulation 304, school boards must develop a school year calendar for elementary and secondary schools that includes 194 school days (including seven Professional Activity Days) between September 1 and June 30 with up to 10 days designated as examination days for secondary schools.



WHAT'S NEW FOR 2018/2019

GRADE 10

Thresholds – HIGHLY RECOMMENDED

- **MPM2D1 – Must have 70% or better in MPM1D1**
You cannot go to MPM2D1 from MFM1P1.
- **ENG2D1 – Should have a minimum of 70% in ENG1D1 OR**
80 - 85% in ENG1P1.
- **SNC2D1 – Should have a minimum of 70% in SNC1D1 OR**
80 - 85% in SNC1P1
