# PATHWAYS

 College courses-lead to C (college), or M (college/university) level courses in Grade 12

 University-leads to M(college/university) or U (university) level courses in Grade 12

# SHSM PROGRAMS

- Grade 11 and 12 program
- Earn certifications and training within program.
- Speak to a teacher in Visual Arts or Hospitality and Tourism
- Arts and Culture
  - 8 credit package including 4 Arts courses
- Hospitality and Tourism
  - 9 credit package including 4 major credits in any combination of Hospitality, Hairstyling, Travel and Tourism or Science courses

- 2 credit (half day) COO3O8

- Requires application
