**CHOOSING COURSES FOR
GRADE 11**

PLANNING FOR SUCCESS

- **Map out a plan for Grade 10 to 12 on Educational Planner sheet**
 - **2 compulsory credits have been filled in; you decide what level to take them at**
 - **6 optional credits need to be selected by you**
 - **Choose 8 courses total**
 - **Make sure you are planning for your post secondary destination (apprenticeship, college, university, workplace)**

PATHWAYS

- **Courses at the Grade 11 level:**
 - **College (C)**
 - **University (U)**
 - **College/University (M)**
 - **Workplace (E)**
 - **Open (O)**

PATHWAYS

- **College courses—lead to C (college), or M (college/university) level courses in Grade 12**
- **University—leads to M(college/university) or U (university) level courses in Grade 12**

SHSM PROGRAMS

- **Grade 11 and 12 program**
- **Earn certifications and training within program.**
- **Speak to a teacher in Visual Arts or Hospitality and Tourism**
- **Arts and Culture**
 - **8 credit package including 4 Arts courses**
- **Hospitality and Tourism**
 - **9 credit package including 4 major credits in any combination of Hospitality, Hairstyling, Travel and Tourism or Science courses**

CO-OP OPTIONS

- 2 credit (half day) COO308
- 4 credit (full day) COOFT1
- 110 hours/credit required
- Requires application
- System Placements
 - Some competitive, board-wide placements
 - Police, Cable 14, Hospitals
 - Require interview and additional application
- System Programs
 - Healthcare Support Program, Building from the Ground up, Militia
 - Require interview and additional application

- **See a cooperative education teacher**

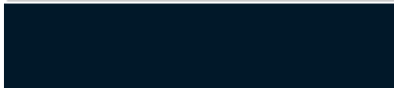
