RETURNING GRADE 12 STUDENTS

Grade 12 Students may return if:

- ✓ They have not graduated due to insufficient credits.
- ✓ They have less than 34 credits Including upgrades. (Post Grads)
- Students who are on an IEP

RETURNING GRADE 12 STUDENTS

Grade 12 Students may return if:

- ✓ They are applying to a System Program, OYAP, or Mohawk Bridge.
- ✓ Post Grads will Need to fill out an Application to return & requires approval.
- Post Grads return can return for 1 Semester ONLY

RETURNING GRADE 12 STUDENTS

Returning Grade 12 Students MUST be:

- ✓ FULL TIME and carry a minimum of 3 courses in a semester.
- Committed to their School Responsibilities.
- Be actively working towards Graduation or upgrading for post secondary destination.

GRADE 12 STUDENTS NOT RETURNING

Grade 12 Students who are NOT Returning MUST:

 Log into Career Cruising and choose the "Not Returning" (NOTRET) option.
