## **VOLUNTEERS IN THE SCHOOL**

It is the policy of the Hamilton-Wentworth District School Board to support and encourage the participation of volunteers in Board activities.

### **Role of the Volunteer**

- ⇒ Volunteers will perform their assigned duties as directed by Board staff
- ⇒ Volunteers will never be responsible for the discipline or evaluation of students
- ⇒ Volunteers will not be responsible for the identification or diagnosis of learning strengths or difficulties
- ⇒ The participation of Volunteers will be respectful of any Collective Agreement requirements.
- ⇒ Volunteers will maintain in confidence any personal information, shared with them in the performance of their duties, in compliance with the Municipal Freedom of Information and protection of Privacy Act.
- ⇒ Volunteers will follow dress and behavioural codes as established by the school.
- ⇒ Volunteers will report to the school office on arrival, to sign-in and if applicable, will wear an identification badge at all times while in the school. They will also sign-out at the office and return their badge, before leaving the school.
- ⇒ Volunteers will notify their supervising teacher / staff member of any expected absence, as far in advance as possible.



## **VOLUNTEERS NEEDED**

At Pauline Johnson we are delighted to have parent volunteers. Volunteers are a tremendous help to our students as they support the learning activities in the classroom.

We also need volunteers who can **organize fundraising activities** that support many of the school related experiences that enhance the learning of our students.

**HWDSB and Pauline Johnson School, with the support of our School Council, asks that all volunteers provide us with a Vulnerable Sector Screening (police check) for the safety of our students.**

Anyone intending to volunteer should come to the office to obtain a volunteer letter signed by the Principal or Vice-Principal that they will take to the Central Police Station when they go to apply for the Vulnerable Sector Screening. This check must be done prior to being assigned any volunteer duties in the school.

## **VISITORS**

Just a reminder that ALL visitors to our school need to report to the office immediately upon arrival to sign in. The safety of all the students in our school is a concern for all of us, so your cooperation is greatly appreciated.

Parents are also asked not to enter a classroom unless they have made an appointment, in advance with the classroom teacher.

When an appointment is needed to speak with a staff member, it should be requested for before or after school, not during classroom time. Your assistance with this is greatly appreciated.



## **CROWDED HALLWAYS**

Our hallway traffic has increased significantly to the point where it has become a safety concern.

- ⇒ **We are requesting that parents NOT accompany their students into the school at entry or dismissal times as the increased congestion in the hallways makes it unsafe for our children.**
- ⇒ The school grounds are supervised 15 minutes before school begins and 15 minutes after school ends.
- ⇒ As there is no scheduled supervision in the hallways before the 8:15 am start of the school day bell, students should not be at their lockers prior to this time.
- ⇒ Our staff escort the children into the building at entry time and out of the building at dismissal and will assist them with their clothing if needed.

Your co-operation with this concern is appreciated.

## **WINTER IS COLD AND FLU SEASON**

If your child comes to school with cold or flu systems, please send them with a box of Kleenex to help stop the spread of germs. Donations of Kleenex, to your child's classroom, are greatly appreciated all through the year!

**Remembrance Day**

On Remembrance Day (November 11) and during Remembrance Week (November 5 to 11), we pay tribute to the men and women of all backgrounds who have served and continue to serve our country during times of war, conflict and peace.

At Pauline Johnson we want to also acknowledge the Aboriginal Veterans who served both in the Canada's Military Forces and as allies, from the formative times of the War of 1812 to the present. Their military contributions were essential to Canada's Survival in earlier times.

**NO NUT SCHOOL!**

There are students and staff in our building who have allergies to nuts and nut products. It is important that you avoid sending peanut butter or any foods that contain nut products in your child's lunch. This includes **Nutella**, and other similar spreads. Although WOW Butter is acceptable, unless you have a sticker on their lunch, please do not send it as we have no way to ensure it is not a nut product. Please remind your child to wash their hands carefully before school and after lunch and to make sure they put all their lunch garbage and food waste in the garbage containers provided in the lunch rooms. This will help prevent accidental contact with these products by those with Nut allergies.



**KISS AND DROP AREA:**

Just a reminder to drivers that our "Kiss and Drop" area is supervised between 8:00 am - 8:15 am every morning.

- ⇒ The Kiss and Drop area is located on the North side of the school.
- ⇒ Our Kiss and Drop area can be used by parents to drop off students from JK to Grade 8.
- ⇒ JK/SK parents may also use this "valet" lane to drop off their child(ren).
- ⇒ A staff member (wearing an orange vest) will greet you at your car and will escort your child to the designated kindergarten staff to ensure safety. This means that you do not have to park and escort your child.



Please obey staff who are directing the flow of traffic and do not leave your vehicle in the Kiss and Drop lane.

**PARKING SAFETY**

We have a serious concern for the safety of all our students and having your assistance in this important safety issue will help to eliminate the chance of a serious accident.

Students are not to walk / run through the staff parking lot at any time. This is a serious safety concern, and we ask that parents reinforce with their child(ren) that the parking lots are for staff use only. We would also like to ask parents not to use the staff parking lots to drop off or pick up students and to not block the entrance to the staff parking lots or to block our neighbours' driveways. 
**PERCH STORE LOCATED IN THE FRONT FOYER**

**LEAVING SCHOOL FOR LUNCH**

A reminder to our **Grade 8** students that to ensure student safety, the school requires a signed and dated note from one of their parents giving them permission to leave the school grounds on a specific day.

- ⇒ Dated and signed notes are to be **handed in to the office, 1st thing in the morning.**
- ⇒ Students with a note may leave the school during **2nd nutrition break only**
- ⇒ Students must be **back on time ... before 1:15 pm.**
- ⇒ Students must be finished eating when they return as food is not to be brought into the classrooms.
- ⇒ Parents please talk to your child about planning these outings ahead as **they must bring a note** from you on the day to be able to leave our school grounds ... please no phone messages or text messages.

**LUNCHROOM ABSENCES**

Students are expected to be in their assigned lunchroom every break, unless, they are ill and absent from school.

Lunchroom students are not allowed to leave the school property at lunch for any reason unless they have handed in a **SIGNED AND DATED NOTE** from a parent to the office prior to the start of the day.

Students are to return to school before 1:15 pm.

- ◆ Eat and converse quietly

## SCHOOL CASH ON-LINE

For safety and efficiency reasons, HWDSB would like to reduce the amount of cash and checks received by our schools. Please join the thousands of parents who have already registered and are enjoying the convenience of paying online. It takes less than five minutes to register.

Please follow the step-by-step instructions to begin receiving email notifications regarding upcoming events involving your child(ren).

**NOTE:** *If you require assistance, select the "SUPPORT" option at the top right hand corner of the screen.*

### STEP 1: Register

- ⇒ If you have not registered, please go to the School Cash Online home page <https://hwdsb.schoolcashionline.com> and select the "Get Started Today" option.
- ⇒ Complete each of the 3 Registration Steps
- ⇒ *\*For security reasons your **password** requires eight characters, one uppercase letter, one lowercase letter and a number.*

### STEP 2: Confirmation Email

- ⇒ A registration confirmation email will be forwarded to you.
- ⇒ Click on the link provided inside the email to confirm your email and School Cash Online account.
- ⇒ The confirmation link will open the School Cash Online site prompting you to sign into your account. Use your email address and password just created with your account.

### STEP 3: Find Student

This step will connect your children to your account.

- ⇒ Verify the **School Board Name** ... Select the **School Name** ... Enter Your **Child's First Name, Last Name** and **Date of Birth**.
  - ⇒ Select "**Continue**" ... On the next page **confirm that you are related** to the child ... check in the **Agree** box and select "**Continue**"
- Your child has been added to your account.

### STEP 4: View Items or Add Another Student

If you have **more children**,

- ⇒ Select "**Add Another Student**" and ... **repeat the steps above**.
- ⇒ Eight (8) children can be added to one parent account.

If you **do not wish to add additional children** ... select "**View Items For Students**" option for a list of available items for purchase.

## Payment Methods: Three (3) Online Options

### Option 1: myWallet

An online wallet that can be loaded to hold funds and pay for items on School Cash Online.

- \* myWallet eliminates the need to enter payment information multiple times.
- \* Simply sign into your account ... and select the myWallet tab.
- \* Click Add Funds to myWallet ... and use an eCheque to load funds into your account.
- \* Once the funds are available ... add all items into your shopping cart and
- \* Select the myWallet payment method in your checkout options.

### Option 2: eCheque

- ◇ This is an electronic version of a paper cheque used to make payments online.
- ◇ Anyone with a chequing/ savings account can pay by eCheque through School Cash Online.
- ◇ To pay with an eCheque, simply enter your routing and account number on the payment screen and click Submit.
- ◇ This option is best suited to families who do not incur bank transaction fees for each cheque/ withdrawal.

### Option 3: Credit Cards

- ◆ Due to parent demand, we now accept payment by VISA or Mastercard.

### ADDITIONAL INFO:

Families will still have the option to send cash or cheque for school-related expenses.

However, we encourage you to get on board with our new service.

School Cash Online's top priority is keeping your personal information safe.

School Cash Online adheres to the highest industry standards of security.

If at any time during the registration process you need help, the **Parent Help Desk is available** to solve any puzzles that parents may have when using School Cash Online, or to answer questions regarding online security. Our friendly staff are available **24/7 (365 days)**. They can assist parents with:
