WINTER CLOTHING AT RECESS:

Please remind your children that it is our expectation (the school's and yours) and it is their responsibility to get dressed properly before going outside.

With up to 25 children in a class, teachers do not have the time to check each child individually. Dressing properly is part of teaching our children independence and responsibility.

Students should have ready to wear clothing that includes: a winter coat, boots, hat and mitts.

A double layer of pants or snow pants are also a good idea, especially for our younger students.

We had some winter clothing donated and it is available in the office if needed



TOBACCO CONTROL ACT

A reminder to parents and guardians that it is illegal to smoke on school property. 'No Smoking' signs are posted at all entrances to the school.

ELECTRONIC CIGARETTES ACT

Beginning January 1, 2016, the Act makes it illegal to use e-cigarettes (vapes) in non-smoking areas including:

- ⇒ A school (including school property)
- ⇒ An enclosed public place
- ⇒ A day nursery within the meaning of the Day Nurseries Act (including outdoor area used by the children)
- ⇒ Child care centre within the meaning of the Child Care and Early Years Act (including outdoor area used by the children)
- ⇒ An enclosed workplace
- ⇒ Within 20 metres of any point of the perimeter of a children's playground where the public is permitted
- ⇒ Within 20 metres of any point of the perimeter of a sporting area where the public is permitted

As with tobacco, supplying or selling e-cigarettes and component parts (e.g. battery, atomizer, liquid) to anyone under the age of 19 is illegal.

Re: Free and Sliding Scale Mental Health Counselling Services for Child, Youth, and Family Family Kinnections is a mental health counselling agency that offers psychotherapeutic interventions for children, teens, and families in Hamilton and Oakville. Our mission is to activate change within individuals, families, and their greater systems, so as to assist them in achieving happiness, harmony and wellness.

Given the elongated waiting time for many parents to access psychotherapeutic interventions for their children in Hamilton, Ontario, we have recently launched an Intern Mental Health Counselling program for students studying Counselling Psychology at the Master's Level. This programme offers no waitlists and services are provided for free, and on a sliding scale, based on household incomes.

The interns have been trained in Cognitive Behavioural Therapy, Dialectical Behavioural Therapy, Family Therapy, and Collaborative Problem Solving treatment modalities. Under my direct supervision, our Intern-Counsellors provide counselling for children and their families who present with:

- Depression
- · Anxiety
- · ADHD
- · Problematic Behaviour
- Anger
- · Parenting Challenges
- · Difficulty Expressing Emotions
- Self-Esteem, etc.

We are, therefore, soliciting your assistance in sharing this information with your patients as a viable option to alleviating their psychosocial challenges. Step 1: REGISTER

If you have not registered, please go to the School Cash Online home page at https://hwdsb.schoolcashonline.com and select the "Get Started Today" option.

*For security reasons your password requires eight characters, including one uppercase letter, one lowercase letter and a number.

a)Complete each of the three Registration Steps

b)Opt in to receive notification by email when new items become available.

Step 2: CONFIRMATION EMAIL

You will receive an email confirming your registration. When you receive this email, click on the link provided inside the email to confirm your email and your desire to have a School Cash Online account.

The confirmation link will open the School Cash Online site prompting you to sign into your account.

Use your email address and the password you just created with your account.

Step 3: TO FIND A STUDENT

Note: Student number is not required ... This step will connect your child(ren) to your account.

Verify the school board name

Select the school name

Enter the **custom PIN code provided** (on the original flyer)

Enter your child's name & birth date

Select confirm

On the next page confirm that you are related to the child, check in the Agree box and select Continue

Your child has been added to your account

Step 4: TO VIEW ITEMS OR ADD ANOTHER STUDENT

If you have more children, select 'Add another Student' and repeat the steps above.

Up to five children can be added to one parent account.

If you do not wish to add additional children, select 'View Items For Students'.

A listing of available items for purchase will be displayed.

PAYMENT METHODS: THREE ONLINE OPTIONS

Option 1: myWallet

An online wallet that can be loaded to hold funds and pay for items on School Cash Online.

It can take up to 7 days from the date the funds are loaded until the funds are verified and available for making payments.

myWallet eliminates the need to enter payment information multiple times.

Simply sign into your account and select the myWallet tab.

Click Add Funds to myWallet and use an eCheque to load funds into your account.

Once the funds are available, add all items into your shopping cart and ... select the myWallet payment method in your checkout options.

Option 2: eCheque

An electronic version of a paper cheque used to make payments online. Anyone with a chequing/savings account can pay by eCheque through School Cash Online.

To pay with an eCheque, simply enter your routing and account number on the payment screen and click Submit.

This option is best suited for families who do not incur bank transaction fees for each cheque/withdrawal.

Option 3: Credit Cards

Due to parent demand, we now accept payment by VISA or MasterCard.

Families still have the option to send cash for school-related expenses. However, we encourage you to get on board with our new service. School Cash Online's top priority is keeping your personal information safe. School Cash Online adheres to the highest industry standards of security. School Cash Online will never contact you to obtain confidential information by phone, email or mail.
