He was dressed in all black and wore a ski mask. Several shots were fired throughout the church killing 26 people. He then exited the church and as he was doing so, he was confronted by a resident of the town who was also armed. They both shot at each other and Kelley was able to get away in his car. Police officers later found him dead inside of his car. He had three gunshot wounds, one which the medical examiner said he did himself. A selfish act like that should not have happened. 
