1. Housekeeping Items - Sue Dunlop

2. Key Considerations from WG#7 - round-table discussion

Committee agreed with including the following revised key considerations in the Interim Report. Revised or additional considerations in green text.

- Funding Opportunities
- School Condition
 - Funding Opportunities and School Condition replaced the single heading of School Condition and Funding Opportunities
- Community Hub
- Traffic and Student Safety

Sue Dunlop noted the following regarding the staff recommendation: we have an obligation to create a recommendation that follows the guiding principles and to present our best business case. We will likely be going with a variation of Idea C. The trustees don't always go with the staff recommendation. They look at all information presented. They have been present at our meetings, they are listening to you and the public.

4. **Dot-'Mocrasy'** – the committee reviewed and discussed their preferences on Ideas A-E (as presented at Public Meeting #2) as well as the Staff Initial Option. using the dotmocracy process.

Discussion:

- There was discussion surrounding the French Immersion program and for optimal success of the program, there should be at least 2 classes of each grade.
- The desire of dual-track schools and the Board's LTFMP guiding principles of at least a 60/40 balance needs to be worked toward and achieved at Earl Kitchener. Discussion was had about the possibility of making the FI catchment for EK match the English catchment. This is to assist in the balancing of the two programs and to reduce the number of students at EK and Ryerson. An alternative was suggested to have the EK FI catchment encompass the English catchments for EK and Central. Another important point in this discussion was that Bennetto would benefit from a larger FI catchment as there are too few students in that school.
