

This new high school will be located southwest of the intersection of Rymal and Upper Sherman. It boasts many design features that will create collaborative learning environments. Learning spaces at Nora Frances Henderson are designed so that students can work together and help each other learn. The Learning Commons (library) is located in the centre of the school. Classrooms share breakout areas where students can collaborate.

The school will also appeal to those seeking an environment that fosters health and wellness. Through its track and field facility, competition-level triple gym, outdoor basketball court and multi-purpose indoor fitness playground, Nora Frances Henderson will help students learn while staying healthy and well.

The school also supports the arts. Students will enjoy the central courtyard for outdoor eating, learning, art and presentations. The school also has a black box theatre for small group performances. Large labs for Transportation, Manufacturing, Construction and Integrated Technology courses will allow students to design and build full-scale projects. The school will also offer a Cosmetology program in a state-of-the-art learning environment.
